

Hello,

Please provide me a quick price quote for an urgent job. It's for a yard sign art that I have had printed at Staples, for a price of around \$10.50.

Final dimensions of the two halves, when placed side-by-side, are 22" X 17". But the file is split into two parts, 11" X 17" each. This idea was a way to slash the cost of printing and laminating one large page.

And download the PDF. Then:

- 1) Please print each of two halves on 11"X17" page (cheapest white paper)
- 2) Cut the white strip from the INSIDE EDGE of JUST ONE of the halves, so both halves fit together perfectly, with no seem.
- 3) Laminate both sides
- 4) Ask the customer if they can trim the laminate around the edge, using scissors, to save the small charge.

This should cost about \$10 to \$11 to do the above.

Please call me right away with the price and I will tell you the quantity to print, and to say if I would like to pay the rush fee.
